Be VISIBLE

Only public pressure can put GM on the agenda

- Write to newspapers, call-in to radio shows take every opportunity to voice your views about GMOs.

Be DISRUPTIVE

Stop GM foods creeping onto our plates

- Read labels complain if you find GM foods in the shop.
- Ask restaurants/take-aways about GMO cooking oil & refuse to eat food cooked in it.
- Ask your favourite food brands if they contain GMOs. Tell them you would not buy their products if they did.
- Ask your schools, hospitals & offices to serve non-GM fed meat, milk & eggs.

Be a MULTIPLIER

Spread the word to your friends, family & community

- Post GMO-related tweets & Facebook updates.
- Follow non-GMO organisations so you can share links with others.
- Host a GMO OMG film night or event to talk about GMOs. Beyond GM can help.
